

SCHEDULE A - RESIDENTIAL & GENERAL SERVICE

A. Availability: (1/1/99)

Available to primary residences, farms, and small domestic services, for year round uses subject to the established rules and regulations.

B. Type of Service: (1/1/99)

Single or three phase service, 60 hertz, alternating current, at standard secondary voltages.

C. Monthly Rate: (4/20/06)

D. Basic Charges: (4/20/06)

The basic charge under the above rate shall be \$17.00 per month where 50 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. Members requiring transformer capacity larger than 50 KVA will be metered for demand and charged a demand charge of \$4.70 per Kw in lieu of the basic charge.

E. Connect - Reconnect: (1/1/99)

If a member disconnects a general service account, and then reconnects within a twelve month period, the member will be required to pay the basic charge for all disconnected months, plus the reconnect fee, unless the service is for an approved public purpose meter in which case only a connect fee will be charged.

F. Minimum Monthly Charge: (1/1/99)

If three phase service is required, the minimum monthly charge shall be \$1.00 per kva of transformer capacity or the contractual minimum.

G. Low Income Senior Citizen & Disabled Discount: (1/1/99)

Members who are receiving Social Security or SSI income, and have household income below 150% of the Federal Poverty Level for two people, may receive a 10% discount on the electric bill for their primary residence by making application at the Cooperative office.

H. Terms of Payment: (1/1/99)

Subject to the established credit policy of the Cooperative.
