

## SCHEDULE D - LARGE COMMERCIAL SERVICE

### A. Availability (1/1/99)

Available to all large commercial consumers desiring more than 50 Kva but less than 1,000 Kva of transformer capacity, subject to established rules and regulations.

### B. Type of Service (1/1/99)

Single or three phase, 60 hertz, alternating current, at standard secondary voltages.

### C. Distribution Charges (4/20/06)

1. Monthly Charge (4/20/06)	\$33.00 per Month
2. Demand Charge (4/20/06)	\$4.70 per kW
3. Line Charge (4/20/06)	\$.0091 per kWh
4. Transmission Charges (1/1/99)	\$.0055 per kWh
5. Energy Charges (4/20/06)	\$.024 per kWh

### D. Power Factor Adjustment (1/1/99)

For Large Commercial accounts who have 500 Kva, or more, of transformer capacity, the consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted to correct for average power factor lower than 95%. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the measured demand 1% for each 1% by which the average power factor is less than 95%.

### E. Minimum Monthly Charge (1/1/99)

The minimum monthly charge shall be \$1.00 per Kva of transformer capacity or the contractual minimum.

### F. Terms of Payment (1/1/99)

Subject to the established credit policy of the Cooperative.
